

### **Event 3: Field Trip Schedule: Monday May 6**

**Field Trip Plan – the bus is available for 47 people - must be at church at 8:00**

- **8:00 to 8:30** – load bus; will leave immediately when loaded
- **8:30 to 8:35** – travel to **Art and Rachael Reist Family Barn**  
980 Eden Ave. Lancaster, PA.
- **8:35 to 10:10** – spend ~ 1 ½ hours touring the barn. See and hear about museum quality artifacts such as wagons, vehicles, tools, and blacksmith materials, etc. from this time period, watch a live demo of a team of oxen be connected to a vintage Conestoga Wagon, hear about the road systems, fledgling turnpike system, and the great wagon road, hear about the economy of the area, and the replenishment pipeline of goods between Lancaster and Philadelphia and then Lancaster to Valley Forge during the 1776 encampment. Single Rest Room in bus and another in house.
- **10:10 – 10:25** travel back to church for rest stop, if needed
- **10:25 to 10:40** – travel to **the Edward Hand House at Rock Ford Plantation** *NOTE: tight schedule – must be at house for tour by 11:00.*

- **11:00 to 12:00**– Edward Hand House near the Conestoga River (house and museum tour). Edward Hand was General Washington’s physician and he built a home at Rock Ford on the Conestoga River.

- **12:21 to 1:15** – 55 minute lunch at Columbia Diner.
- **1:15 to 1:22** – travel to Wheatland
- **1:30 to 3:30** – Wheatland is President Buchanan’s home. Tour of the Museum and Tour of Wheatland Home.
- **3:30 to 4:00** Time to browse the gift shop.
- **4:00 to 4:30** return to church parking lot
