**Mr. David R Johnson** is currently President of the East Petersburg Historical Society and is an independent researcher and writer. He will discuss the colonial history of Lancaster County focusing on the various groups that made this area their home. He has published articles in several journals including the Pennsylvania Mennonite Heritage Magazine (PMH) and Der Reggebooge magazine.

**Dr. Marlene Arnold** is a Cultural Anthropologist from Millersville University. She will speak about the research she began in the late 1990’s on the history of Lancaster County in the 1700’s. Dr. Arnold’s research has become known as the Providence Project. Through her research, she discovered that many American values originated from small towns in SE Pennsylvania. Her research also focuses on the cultures that made up Lancaster County in the 1700’s and the cohesion and friction among those groups of people.
