### HURRICANE MARIA 2017

- Hurricane Maria was a deadly Category 5 hurricane that devastated Dominica, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico in September 2017. It is regarded as the worst natural disaster on record to affect those islands and is also the deadliest Atlantic hurricane since Jeanne in 2004.
- It has been almost two years since **Hurricane Maria** wreaked havoc on **Puerto Rico**. The recovery work continues. Highland's team will be working with PDA. We do not know what the work might be, but *"you shall be called repairers of the breach"* — *Isaiah 58*. We will learn what work we will be doing closer to our October date.
- The estimated cost per person will be less than \$800.00.
