Brass Banding

The Lancaster British Brass Band follows a path first laid down in the smoky mill and mining towns of mid 19th-century Britain.

Gradually evolving into a fixed instrumentation of 28 players and one conductor, brass bands flourished under the sponsorship of mill and mine owners bent on “morale and spiritual uplift.” This laid the groundwork for a later time when the Salvation Army began capitalizing on the success of these bands by establishing them as part of their outreach through music.

For concert programs, brass bands borrow from virtually every musical genre. A typical program consists of transcriptions of the classics, marches, hymns, popular music arrangements, solos—and last but not least—original compositions written for the medium. Programs are selected for a balanced presentation that attempts to please a wide range of tastes and interests.

The band is currently in its 18th season of music making. Walter Blackburn was the band’s conductor for its first seven years, followed by Stephen Allen, who is currently in his 11th year as music director and conductor.
