She has subbed at the Fulton Theatre in their pit orchestra and performed with the popular local ensemble, Vivace Live. Ms. Crosby additionally teaches at the Community Music School in Collegeville, PA and out of her home. Ms. Crosby is twice a graduate of Temple University, most recently having earned a Master of Music degree. Her teachers include Ms. Diana Morgan, Dr. Adeline Tomasone, Ms. Eileen Grycky, and Dr. Lynne Cooksey.



Doug Wimer graduated from Philadelphia College of Bible [now Cairn University] with a B.S. degree in Bible and Bachelor of Music degrees in Piano Performance and Vocal Performance. Postgraduate studies followed at Westminster Choir College, Princeton, NJ, where he received a Master of Music degree with distinction in Organ Performance. Doug is currently the organist and choirmaster at St. Stephen Reformed Church PCA, New Holland. He is also the owner/president of the Buch Organ Company and former Dean of the Lancaster Chapter of the American Guild of Organists. He resides in the Ephrata area with his wife Joy.
