## About the Music

Composers have long taken inspiration from the Mass - the Roman Catholic celebration of the Eucharist, or communion. Robert Ray's **Gospel Mass** (1981) was inspired by the religious and cultural changes of the 1960s, including the introduction of vernacular languages to the Mass. Ray brings the sounds of jazz and African-American music to this setting. **100 Years of Broadway** is a choral medley that quickly takes us from the start of the genre in the 1940s until its golden years in the 1950s and '60s. In this revue, you'll recognize snippets from A Chorus Line, the Sound of Music, Oklahoma, Annie Get Your Gun, Carousel, and others.
