Pastor Allison Marks Her One-Year Anniversary at Highland

Last week, I preached a sermon that marked my one year anniversary with Highland. I talked about what it means to be a *multi-layered leader*. Those layers include: an organizational leader, a shepherd leader, and a gardener leader. The organizational leader pays attention to systems and processes. The shepherd leader focuses on relationships and caring for the flock. And the gardener leader makes sure the beloved community is grounded in the narrative of hope, the Word of God. The gardener makes sure the environment is right for God to produce growth. Reflecting on this last year, as an organizational leader, I've come alongside you to accomplish the following:

- We began Ignite, our extended worship time that features the many talents of our praise band. This process included leading the staff through a period of discernment, hosting listening sessions to create something that was wanted and needed by church members, and hiring Jeff Martin to be our Ignite worship leader.
- We updated all job descriptions and completed staff performance reviews, using a brand new evaluation process.
- We initiated a new evaluation process for our installed pastors using the "coaching and equipping" model designed by the Presbytery of Donegal.
- We initiated a strategic planning process which included a time of discernment to decide on a strategic planning consultant, the formation of a strategic planning team (the GPS), and the launch of "40 days of prayer" to begin this process on a solid foundation of prayer and the Word.
- We created a new format for staff meetings that includes a time of learning, team building, and sharing "God sightings" or moments where we saw God at work at Highland.
- We re-structured the session assignments so that every committee has a session liaison to increase communication.

As a shepherd leader, I have met so many of you as I made my way through most of the nursing homes and assisted living centers in the area. Every Monday morning, I visit our homebound members or online worshippers, making connections with them and bringing them greetings from Highland. I have walked with some of you in planning funerals for your loved ones and getting your children baptized (my favorite!). I've met you in fellowship events and Bible studies, picnics and hospital rooms. I've also met most of our mission partners in the city, often taking tours of facilities and meeting staff that work there. One of my goals this coming year is to continue establishing relationships with Highland members as well as our mission partners. And finally, as a gardener leader, I hope and I pray that I have preached sermons that matter—sermons that inspire—and sermons that lead you closer to the Lord. I pray that God continues to give me the right words to say to make meaning in this season of Highland's life and to situate us in a narrative of hope. Thank you, Highland, for trusting my leadership and walking alongside me the way that I have promised to walk alongside you. I'm excited for the future and eager to see where God leads us next! Church Directory Did you know that there is a church directory that can be accessed two ways? Online on the HighlandPC.org website and on a smartphone using the Church Life app.

For Website Access: New Users If you have never registered on the church website, go to www.HighlandPC.org. Scroll to the bottom left of any page, click on CREATE NEW ACCOUNT and register using your email address and then create a password. Your email address is your USERNAME. Sign in and check the accuracy of your information and by selecting "I want to view MY COMPLETE PROFILE".

Existing Users If you have logged in before: Go to Highland's website: www.HighlandPC.org. Scroll to the bottom left of any page, click on MEMBER LOGIN and sign in. After signing in, you now have access to the church directory by using the search box on the right side of the page to access the PHOTO DIRECTORY.

For Smartphone Access:

To access the photo directory from your smartphone, you will need to download the Church Life app: Click on App Store icon on your phone. Search for "ACS Church Life" app and download it. The first time you use the Church Life app it will ask you to enter your email address and password that you have set up on Highland's website. Enter your information and SIGN IN. Once signed in, you can stay signed in. If you need help editing your information or uploading a photo, go to the WELCOME Page on the church website and scroll down to CHURCH DIRECTORY or by contacting Mike Nolt, our website administrator.
