Purpose of this series:

- 1. To explore our roots as a church
- 2. To encourage the congregation to dream and innovate as the early church did
- 3. To study the Spirit's role in shaping a resilient church To build hope and confidence in our work and our church
- 4. Over-arching questions of the series: What are the characteristics of resilient churches? How can we be a resilient church as we move into our next chapter at Highland?

Resilient churches....

- Week 1 8/27: They trust and have faith that God has a plan even when that plan is not evident. (Acts 1:6-14)
- Week 2 9/3: They discern and move with the Spirit; they dream dreams (Acts 2:1-13)
- Week 3 9/10: They value community and relationships (Acts 4:32-37)
- Week 4 9/17: They boldly and unapologetically tell the story of Jesus (Acts 8:26-40) (Also integrating some scripture from Acts 4- Peter and John refuse to keep quiet about how they healed the man in the name of Jesus; and Acts 5- they still preach in the prisons and refuse to stop)
- Week 5 9/24: They have people who know and use their gifts (Acts 9: 1-20)
- Week 6 10/1: They are nimble, flexible, and open to change (Acts 10: 1-33)
- Week 7 10/8: They maintain their joy and hope even in adversity (Acts 16:16-34)
- Week 8 10/29Final sermon in Acts series; They are able to step out of their comfort zone (Acts 17: 16-31)



Church Directory Did you know that there is a church directory that can be accessed two ways? Online on the HighlandPC.org website and on a smartphone using the Church Life app.

For Website Access: New Users If you have never registered on the church website, go to www.Highlandpc.org. Scroll to the bottom left of any page, click on CREATE NEW ACCOUNT and register using your email address and then create a password. Your email address is your USERNAME. Sign in and check the accuracy of your information and by selecting "I want to view MY COMPLETE PROFILE".

After signing in, you now have access to the church directory by using the search box on the right side of the page to access the PHOTO DIRECTORY.

For Smartphone Access:

To access the photo directory from your smartphone, you will need to download the Church Life app: Click on App Store icon on your phone. Search for "ACS Church Life" app and download it. The first time you use the Church Life app it will ask you to enter your email address and password that you have set up on Highland's website. Enter your information and SIGN IN. Once signed in, you can stay signed in. If you need help editing your information or uploading a photo, go to the WELCOME Page on the church website and scroll down to CHURCH DIRECTORY or by contacting Mike Nolt, our website administrator. Blue papers with instructions can be found on the Kiosk or at The Welcome Center.
