Originally from London, UK, prize-winning organist, conductor, and pianist, **Tyrone Whiting** is Director of Music & Arts at the historic Church of St. Martin-in-the-Fields, Philadelphia.

Tyrone graduated from the Royal College of Music as a scholar from the Postgraduate Diploma in Performance Science course, where he was generously funded by an Arts and Humanities Research Council Studentship and supported by the Douglas and Hilda Simmonds Award. Returning to the RCM in 2016, Tyrone achieved a distinction in the Master of Music degree and received the renowned Harold Darke Prize in 2017.

Tyrone maintains an active performance and teaching portfolio and has played venues across the UK, Europe, and the USA. Recent and future performances include St. Patrick's Cathedral, New York; Longwood Gardens (home to the famous organ competition); St. Thomas Church, Fifth Avenue, New York; and Princeton University Chapel.
