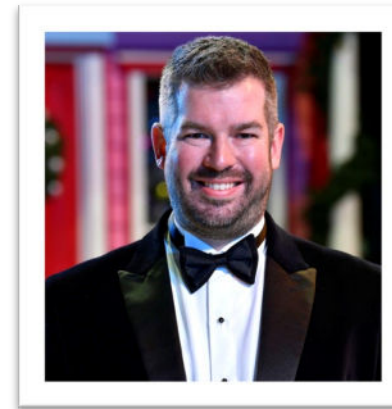

**Paul Thorlakson** is Director of Music at Highland Presbyterian Church and Professor and Chair of Music, Worship, and Performing Arts at Lancaster Bible College. He holds an Associate's Degree from the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto; a Bachelor of Music in Performance from the University of Toronto; and a Master's of Church Music and Doctor of Musical Arts from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, where he also received a Certificate in Performance and an award for Pedagogy. He has continued post graduate studies at the Eastman School of Music and the University of Southern California.

Dr. Thorlakson has enjoyed a varied piano performance career as a recitalist, soloist with orchestra, chamber musician, and accompanist in venues from Christian conference centers to major concert halls. He has served a number of churches in music ministry positions.

His academic career has taken him from Simpson University in Redding, California to Redeemer University in Ontario and Lancaster Bible College. At these institutions, he served as department chair, conducted the college symphony, and taught piano, theory, and music ministry. He is a Senior Examiner for the Royal Conservatory of Music of Toronto and serves as an adjudicator for festivals and competitions. Paul is married to Sharon and has three adult daughters, Rachel, Aubrey, and Emily.

**Jonathan Lefever** currently serves as the Organist and IT & Media Coordinator at Highland Presbyterian Church. A Lancaster County native who freelances as a performer and conductor, he has most recently been seen as Music Director and Associate Music Director at the Fulton Theatre and American Music Theatre.
