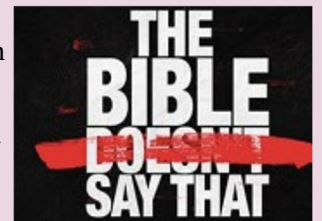

Check the sender's email (official Highland accounts end with @highlandpc.org). When in doubt, confirm by calling the church office before responding.

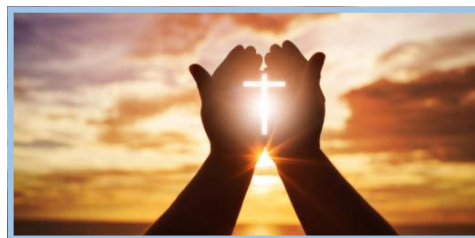
