Supporting Neighbors Facing Food Insecurity

With the ongoing government shutdown, many families have lost their SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits. About one in eight U.S. residents rely on this program to help put food on the table, and its disruption could leave millions struggling to afford groceries.
