Gift cards are available for Giant, Weis, Stauffer's, and Oregon Dairy in \$25 and \$50 denominations, and can be purchased using cash or check. In 2025, the sale of cards increased by more than **\$11,000**, and the church donated **\$3,000** to the Lancaster County Food Hub as a result of your purchases. Thank you to everyone who participated in 2025!

The cost of the flowers and vases continues to rise, and we really need your help. For a \$25 donation, you can honor a special someone or event in your life on a Sunday of your choice.


To honor an individual or event:

Winter Weather Closure Policy


Highland Presbyterian Church will continue to monitor **Manheim Township School District (MTSD)**, but weather decisions will be made based on *actual* conditions and safety, not strictly school status. If Manheim Township School District issues a delay, or if Highland determines road/parking conditions warrant a delay, Highland will operate on a **2-hour delay**.

Gifts That Keep On Giving

Sermon Series: January 4 - February 1

This sermon series follows the lectionary passages from the Gospel of Matthew for the first five Sundays of the new year (with the exception of January 18, when we will step outside the lectionary in order to remain in Matthew).

The birth of Jesus is indeed a gift to all humanity. Unlike most gifts that are given and received once, however, the gift of our Savior continues to bless us over time. While Jesus' birth was a single, historical event, the grace and love we welcome through it are ongoing, shaping our hearts, guiding our thoughts, and directing our actions.

Jesus' arrival is meant to transform us not only on one holy night, but in the ordinary rhythms of daily life. During these first five weeks of the new year, we will reflect on how the gift of Jesus continues to bless us, form us, and lovingly challenge us to grow as disciples.
