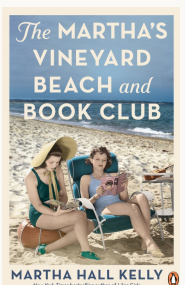
## Legacy Sunday:

## A New Way to Stay Connected: Transitioning to Realm



We are excited to announce that Highland will soon be transitioning to **Realm**, a modern church engagement platform designed to help members stay connected, informed, and engaged in the life of our church.

As many of you may know, the ChurchLife app is no longer available for download and the ACS system that supports it is no longer receiving updates or ongoing support. To ensure we continue providing a reliable and user-friendly experience, we will be transitioning to Realm over the next couple of weeks. For those who currently use the ChurchLife app, it will remain available during the transition period.

Through the Realm Connect mobile app, members will be able to receive church news and event updates, communicate with groups and ministry teams, update personal and family information, view giving history, and discover opportunities to serve within the church community.

Additional information, including instructions for downloading the app and details about upcoming training opportunities, will be shared soon. ## Additional Food Cupboard Collection Site

The **Local Outreach Committee** is pleased to announce a second donation location for the **Food Hub** near the office entrance, in addition to the church collection area. This new cart offers a convenient place to drop off non-perishable food items while attending church activities throughout the week. Donations such as canned goods, pasta, rice, cereal, and peanut butter help keep the Food Cupboard stocked for neighbors in need, and every donation is a meaningful expression of Christ's love and care for our community.

## From Your HPC Session:

### Exploring Opportunities for Stewardship of Our Facilities

At our annual congregational meeting, finance shared concerns about our current budget challenges and the continued rise in expenses associated with maintaining our expansive church facilities. As Session continues to seek responsible ways to support the church's mission and ensure good stewardship of our resources, we are taking a step to explore potential opportunities for additional revenue.

To that end, Session has approved a six-month agreement with a rental agent to help determine whether there may be organizations interested in using portions of our building that are currently unused or used only infrequently during the work week. This agreement is solely for exploration and information gathering. We are not entering into any rental arrangement at this time, nor have any decisions been made regarding future tenants or building use.

The purpose of this process is simply to conduct due diligence and assess whether there is interest from compatible organizations whose use of available space could help generate revenue to support our growing ministries and offset building maintenance costs.

There is no cost to the church for engaging the rental agent during this exploratory period. A fee will only be incurred if the agent successfully identifies a rental partner and a formal agreement is ultimately reached.

Session will continue to keep the congregation informed as information becomes available and appreciates your prayers and support as we explore opportunities that may strengthen the church's ministry and long-term financial sustainability.
